The employee will be required to develop positive working relationships with peers, management, the general public, stakeholders and other functional areas within the organisation.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Essential Qualifications/Experience:

- Proven extensive experience in Retail Operations.
- Demonstrated initiative, thinking and planning.
- Strong relationship building, communication and analytical skills.
- Skills in supervision, reporting and sales budgets.
- Ability to multi-task, plan and manage people and processes to effectively achieve outcomes.
- Demonstrated capacity to supervise paid staff and volunteer workforce.
